Nominations for District Award of Merit must be made on the BSA National form.

Please check the Award you are nominating for:

_____ SPARKPLUG AWARD – This award is for a NEW SCOUTER (registered and active in scouting between six months and one year) who has demonstrated attitude and service reflecting exemplary scout spirit and the ideals of the Scouting program. This person has made an immediate and noticeable impact as a leader. This award may be earned each time the nominee moves into a new scout program.

_____ AKELA AWARD – This award is for service of an exceptional nature to a pack or to cub scouting at the district level. One year minimum registration in a Cub Scout program is required.

_____ CORNERSTONE AWARD – This award is for service of an exceptional nature to a unit in the Boy Scout or Varsity Scout program. One year registration in the Boy Scout program is required.

_____ VENTURE COMPASS AWARD – This award is for adult service of an exceptional nature to a qualified Venture program. One year minimum registration in a Venture program is required.

_____ LIFETIME SERVICE AWARD – This award is for exceptional service over a period of not less than ten years as a registered adult scouting volunteer. Service, consistency, effectiveness and length of tenure are all considered. The district is not required to select an individual every year.

_____ ERNEST THOMPSON SETON AWARD – This award is for exceptional adult service and longevity in a Cub Scout program. Intended for the adult who chooses to stay at the Cub Scouting level and who demonstrates exemplary mentorship, dedication and leadership. A minimum of 5 years service desired.

Adults nominated for these awards must be registered with Sandia District. Selection will be based on contribution to scouting, length of service, effectiveness as a leader, and demonstration of scouting ideals.
